If you have misplaced your admission certificate or never received it, we can reissue it.

What you get

A replacement admission certificate states:

- your name at the time of admission
- your SRA number
- your admission date

If you were admitted before 1 October 2009, the replacement certificate may not be in the same format as the original.

Who can apply

- Solicitors admitted to the roll of solicitors in England and Wales can apply for a replacement admission certificate.
- We cannot accept requests for replacement admission certificates from third parties.

Fee

There is no fee for a replacement admission certificate.

Apply now

If you never received an admission certificate

- If you were admitted less than six months ago and never received an admission certificate, we can issue you a certificate free of charge. <u>Email us [https://higher-rights.sra.org.uk/home/contact-us/]</u>
- If you were admitted more than six months ago, you must apply for a replacement certificate following the instructions below.
